Dear Church,

During Lent, Union has been invited to go on a journey to Jerusalem with the members of Lynnhurst Congregational UCC. Together we will travel the 6,226 miles from Minneapolis to Jerusalem as we engage in physical movement. For every 15 minutes of physical movement we will complete one mile of the journey. All this movement will help support our spiritual health, create personal connections, and increase our physical health during Lent.

What constitutes 15 minutes of physical activity? Walking, golfing (note to the snowbirds), water aerobics, yoga, light housework, shoveling (see Marv to sign up to shovel on Sundays), swimming, singing (note to choir members), playing a musical instrument, and anything else that gets you from sedentary to moving counts as physical movement towards Jerusalem.

More information will be forthcoming about how to sign up and how to record your miles. I hope you will join me and Lynnhurst members as we journey to Jerusalem.


